The Lord is Your Helper Psalm 121 (KJV) ¹ I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. ² My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.

- As the singers of the psalms traveled toward the Temple in Jerusalem, they would lift up their eyes to see the hills in the distance
- As they traveled up the hills, they wondered where their help would come from
- The singing pilgrims understood that God's protective care is along their journey and their destination
- It was in these uncertain and threatening times they needed God's help
- The pilgrims realized their help came from God who made heaven and earth
- The Lord is the maker of heaven and earth, and it tells us three things about the Lord, the Lord:
 - 1. Is the one true and living God, not idols or false gods
 - 2. Is supreme over all things, including our lives and our future
 - 3. Is all-powerful; He who *made* all things is greater that all things
- As you and I journey through life, it's easy to focus on the trials, the challenges, and the uncertainties
- We must lift up pour eyes to the Lord and remember He is always available to help us at all times *Hebrews 4:16 Let us* therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.
- We don't have to fear nor faint when we face trials, adversity, and challenges on our life's journey because the One who made heaven and earth is our helper!

The Lord is Your Guardian

³ He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber. ⁴ Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.

- In addition to being our helper, the Lord is our guardian
- As the pilgrims journeyed up to Jerusalem, the Lord watched over them
- To avoid injury the travelers had to do their best to stay alert for potential dangers or distractions
- Despite to potential dangers, the travelers were confident that the Lord was keeping watch over them
- God carefully watches over them so closely, He won't let them slip or fall
- We can only stand in difficult and uncertain circumstances if continue to look to and trust in the One who will not allow our foot to be moved
- The pilgrims could rejoice because the Lord that keeps them never slumbers, He doesn't get drowsy
- When we look to the Lord, we have confidence in the fact the Lord does not sleep
- We can take comfort that He who watches Israel neither slumbers nor sleeps!
- The Lord not only watches His people as a whole, but also individually as you go throughout your daily activities
- The Lord even assigns angels to watch over us to protect wherever we go Psalms 91:11-12 (CEV) God will command his angels to protect you wherever you go. 12 They will carry you in their arms, and you won't hurt your feet on the stones.
- When we walk close to the Lord, He will keep us, watch over us, guard us from the enemy and strengthen us
- When you feel alone or abandoned, remember God is always with you and watching over every step you take

The Lord is Your Protector

⁵ The Lord is thy keeper: the Lord is thy shade upon thy right hand.⁶ The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night.

- One of the greatest dangers in traveling to Jerusalem was the prolonged exposure to the scorching sun
- But the Lord is their keeper and promised to take care of the travelers
- The Lord promised to be their shade from the hot sun
- Shade both protects and refreshes a person
- Shade is also the same word as shadow in **Psalm 91:1 He** that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- We are to live under the protection and shadow of the Lord
- The Lord was always at the travelers right hand, meaning God is always available and always near
- The threat of heatstroke diminished when the sun set, but the night had its own dangers
- But the Lord shaded His people by day and shielded them by night
- The mention of day and night *together* covers all the threats we may face in life
- The scorching sun is of the Middle East is a picture of the trials of life 1 Peter 4:12 CEV Dear friends, don't be surprised or shocked that you are going through testing that is like walking through fire.
- We are not exempt from the heat, pain, the struggle of trials
- Like a huge shade tree, the Lord protects us as we journey through the heat of trials, troubles, and temptations of life
- Day and night the Lord is protecting us 24/7 from whatever situation, problem or threat that may arise
- Because of the Lord's protection we can walk fearlessly by day and peacefully by night

The Lord is Your Keeper

⁷ The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul. ⁸ The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.

- As the pilgrims made their journey through the treacherous terrains, the scorching heat, and dangerous nights they did not fear because the Lord was keeping them
- The Lord was preserving their lives from evil
- Lord would keep them from harm and preserve their soul
- Soul speak more than just the physical body, it's the inner thoughts and emotions too, it's the whole person
- The Lord preserved their going out and coming in
- Just like the phrase days and night, the Lord preserves everything in between
- When trouble arises the Lord will preserve our souls
- When we look at Job, Joseph, Daniel, and Paul; these godly men all went through trials that impacted physically, mentally, financially, and emotionally, but it did not destroy them because the Lord was preserving them
- Despite the challenges along the way, we are kept by the power of God 1 Peter 1:5 Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
- The Lord care for us is comprehensive and eternal
- Embrace the assurance that the Lord is your helper, your guardian, your protector and your keeper!
